## 2. Budget Discussions for the FY2021-2022

Town Finance Officer Marsha Gross presented to the Council with the following items with staff assistance. The presentation information is attached to these minutes and therefore incorporate herein.

- Police Department Budget Chief Dennis Franks <u>Proposed Budget</u>: \$2,728,900 (1.6%/\$43.1K increase)
- Transportation Budget Associate Town Engineer Justin Russell <u>Proposed Budget</u>: \$701,500 (14.1%/\$114.7K decrease)

Council held consensus to add traffic volume as a factor in the Road Repair Plan prioritization.

- Storm Water Budget Associate Town Engineer Justin Russell <u>Proposed Budget</u>: \$490,100 (4.9%/\$25.4K decrease)
- Planning and Zoning Budget Town Planner Lynne Hair <u>Proposed Budget</u>: \$403,100 (3.68%/\$14.3K increase)

- Debt Service Finance Officer Marsha Gross
- General Government Budget Assistant Town Manager Erinn Nichols <u>Proposed Budget</u>: \$1,198,700 (12.4%/\$170.2K decrease)

Council reviewed the remaining meetings scheduled for budget discussion.
