1. <u>Call the Meeting to Order</u>

2. 2024-2025 Budget Retreat

Curt Walton, Walton and Hall, LLC, led the Council in the Town's FY2025 Budget Retreat and explained that over the next two budget sessions the goal was for the Council to develop an understanding of the projected current level costs and revenues. This would give the Town Manager guidance for developing the FY2025 budget in terms of new revenues, service reductions, and two-three budget scenarios to bring back to the Council.

Interim Finance Officer Marsha Gross then reviewed the five-year financial projections for the Town. This presentation is attached to these minutes and therefore incorporated herein.

Mr. Walton requested Council inform Staff of the directions it was leaning for the next fiscal year so that it might prepare further for upcoming budget discussions.
