SPD Detectives had five crime scene callouts and had 9 cases assigned for investigation. CID obtained 14 search warrants and three arrest warrants in ongoing case investigations. The Unit cleared three cases. The department investigated and arrested one person in connection with an internet crime against a child case.																											
Medical call leads to a felony arrest and significant drug seizure. On July 3, 2026, SPD officers were dispatched to a person unresponsive in a vehicle parked in the roadway. Officers along with fire and EMS arrived and determined that the driver was not suffering a medical condition. Further investigation showed that the driver was in possession of several different illegal prescription drugs, drugs that were likely stolen and illegally diverted from the intended patient(s). The suspect was charged with felony drug possession, and over 60 illegal schedule II pills were seized as part of the investigation.																											
On July 19, 2026, SPD officers responded to two separate overdose calls at the same location in Stallings. These two overdose calls were less than 2 hours apart. In addition to investigating the overdose calls, SPD officers also enlisted the assistance of our CID division to help further investigate these overdoses. This investigation resulted in the issuance of a search warrant for the premises where the overdoses occurred and resulted in the seizure of illegal drugs and drug paraphernalia.																											
SPD officers responded to a disturbance call at McGee Corp. Upon arrival, they learned that the subject had fled towards the Intown Suites hotel. Officers on scene identified the female
